

2020 CENSUS - SCHOOL DISTRICT REFERENCE MAP - Mecklenburg County, NC

The map displays various school districts and their corresponding Uni numbers, color-coded by district. Key districts include UNI 02680, UNI 02310, UNI 03120, UNI 02430*, UNI 04050, UNI 00530, UNI 01620, UNI 02970, UNI 04320, UNI 04620, and UNI 04045. Major cities like Charlotte (12000) and Huntersville (33120) are labeled. The map also shows major highways (I-77, I-85, I-95) and surrounding areas like Gaston County and York County.

Where international, state, county, and/or MCD boundaries coincide, the map shows the boundary symbol of the only the highest-ranking of these boundaries.

Geographic area names are followed by either their FIPS or census code.

- 1 MCD boundaries are shown in the following states in which some or all MCDs function as general-purpose governmental units: Connecticut, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Dakota, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Dakota, Vermont, and Wisconsin. (Note that Illinois and Nebraska have some counties covered by nongovernmental precincts but Missouri has most counties covered by nongovernmental townships.)
- 2 A " " following an mcd name denotes a false MCD. A " " following a place name indicates that a false MCD exists with the same name and FIPS code as the place; the false MCD label is not shown.
- 3 Place label color corresponds to the place fill color.
- 4 A " " following a label indicates that the school district is in more than one county.

Due to space limitations, some areas and features such as water bodies, parks, and roads may not be labeled.
